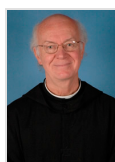

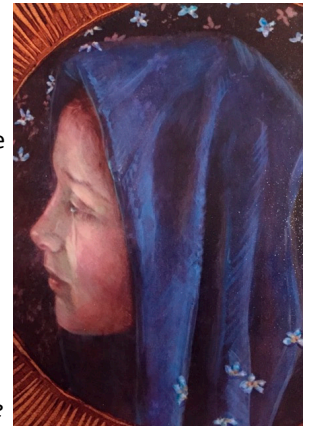

Father Marion's Corner

Weep in gratitude and joy.

Being Catholic is not about following a set of rules and regulations nor is it about doing a multitude of charitable works. Being Catholic is first and foremost being aware that we are deeply loved by God in the person of Jesus Christ. How can we become aware of this truth and be filled with joy?



"God so loved the world that He gave us His only Son." Jn 3:16 "There is no greater love than for a man to lay down his life for his friends." Jn 15:13 This is my body given up for you. "It is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me. So I live in this earthly body by trusting in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me." Gal. 2:20 When was the last time you sat for a moment to reflect on the depth of Christ's love for you? What do you think is happening to your soul as you drink from this fountain of living water?

A young catechist teaching 2nd graders was telling the story of Jesus' last supper, the agony in the garden, the handing over to the authorities before eventual death on the cross out of love for all of us. From the back of the class, a little boy pipes up, *"The story is not true!"* Shocked by the sudden comment, the teacher asks, *"Why did you say such a thing?"* The child responds, *"If it is true, then you can't tell the story without weeping."*

Meditate upon the love of the Lord. Look upon His face and look into His eyes to see the depth of His mercy and compassion. Like Mary, ponder these things within your heart. The idea is to move from "how can we weep in gratitude and joy" to "how can we *not* weep in gratitude and joy".
